The [Fiddler's Hearth Public House](#) in South Bend, IN, has been an advocate for science, and for the benefit of AstroCamp they stepped up again. On March 9, 2014, Fiddler's Hearth hosted a [showing of the premiere](#) of *Cosmos: A SpaceTime Odyssey* that raised almost \$400.00 in donations.

Two evenings prior, on the [First Friday in March](#), the [Michiana Astronomical Society](#) set up telescopes outside the Irish pub to give passers-by a view of earth's moon and of Jupiter and its moons. The sidewalk astronomy generated interest in the
