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Activity: The Platisphere for Children

In the children's version suggested by April Whitt, students draw four seasonal scenes on the background plate that align with a window cut into the starfield plate, which itself has fewer constellations drilled out. This window is positioned just to the right, or east, of Cassiopeia so that the starfield corresponds to early evening hours for the respective seasons.
